## Statement of Non-Discrimination and How to File a Grievance

Texas Health Surgery Center Bedford complies with applicable Federal civil rights laws and does not discriminate based on race, national origin, age, disability, or sex. Texas Health Surgery Center Bedford does not exclude people or treat them differently because of race, national origin, age, disability, or sex.

Texas Health Surgery Center Bedford:

Provides free aids and services to people with disabilities to communicate effectively with us or whose primary language is not English, such as:

- Qualified sign language interpreters
  - Written information in other formats or other languages (large prints, audio, accessible electronic formats, other)
- All patients seeking treatment at our facility are to be treated with respect and dignity. Any treatment
  determinations based on a person's physical status or diagnosis will be made based on medical
  evidence and treatment capacity, and not based on fear or prejudice. Services will be furnished on the
  medical necessity and appropriateness of the service as well as applicable requirements of federal
  and state law and regulations regarding the types of treatment that may appropriately be furnished at
  our facility.
